+ACCESS By Sendai City Buses: Take a bus on route 719 at bus stop no.9 of Sendai Station west exit bus terminal and get off at "Rigakubu Shizenshi Hyouhonkan Mae". It take about 20 minutes. Or take a bus on routes 710, 713, or 715 at bus stop no.9 and get off at "Jouhoukagaku Kenkyuka Mae". Four-minute walk. It takes about 25 minutes in total. **By LOOPLE SENDAI (City Touring Bus):** Take the Loople Sendai from Sendai Station west exit bus terminal (bus stop no.15-3) and get off at Rigakubu Shizenshi Hyouhonkan Mae. (30 min. in total)
